

Notice of Public Hearing

Summer Opt Out Breakfast Program

Public Act 096-0734 requires each school district to implement and operate a School Breakfast Program in the next school year in accordance with federal guidelines in each school building within its district in which at least 50 percent or more of the students are currently eligible for free or reduced price lunches. If a school is seeking an exemption from this mandate, they must petition their Regional Office of Education (ROE) by January 15 of each year. Madison County ROE #41 has received exemption requests from Bethalto CUSD #8, Granite City CUSD #9 Early Childhood Center, Elementary School Buildings, Coolidge Jr. High School and Roxana CUSD #1 Elementary School Buildings.

The Madison County ROE will hold a public hearing on Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. on this matter at their office located in the Madison County Administration Building at 157 North Main Street, Suite 438, Edwardsville, IL, at which time questions or comments can be heard.
